Congress is scheduled to reauthorize the Child Nutrition Programs and the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) in FY2009. The reauthorization bill will include WIC, National School Lunch, School Breakfast Program, Summer Food Service, Child and Adult Care Food, and the WIC Farmers' Market Nutrition Programs. In anticipation of the reauthorization, the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) is gathering information to help clarify the needs and concerns of our Program cooperators, participants, and partners at the State and local levels. I am pleased to invite you to participate in this information-gathering process.

The listening session for this region will take place in Baltimore, Maryland on August 6, 2008 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the Enoch Pratt free Library, Wheeler Auditorium, 400 Cathedral Street.



1. Strengthening Program management and improving nutrition;
2. Ensuring all eligible people have access to program benefits; and
3. Advancing technology and innovation.
