\*\* USDA is going to fast track the regulations governing the additional fruit and vegetable benefits aiming to complete the process in 60 days. Once USDA issues the new regulations, States can add the new funding to the fruit and vegetable vouchers for women. States should be able to implement the additional funding for fruit and vegetable vouchers this winter which could provide nine month of benefits in this fiscal year. All States must implement the new funding by six months after the date of enactment.
