Dear Speaker Johnson, Democratic Leader Jefferies, Majority Leader Thune, Democratic Leader Schumer, Chairwoman Collins, Vice Chair Murray, Chairman Hoeven, Ranking Member Shaheen, Chairman Cole, Ranking Member DeLauro, Chairman Harris, Ranking Member Sanford Bishop:

We the 389 undersigned national, state, and local organizations, urge you to protect and strengthen nutrition and health services for infants, young children, and pregnant and postpartum women by supporting the Senate-passed fiscal year (FY) 2026 funding levels for the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children's (WIC).

The Senate bill, which funds WIC at \$8.2 billion, is anticipated to fully fund the science-backed benefit amounts for all who apply for the program including fully funding the WIC Cash Value Benefit (CVB) for the purchase of critically important fruit and vegetables. Any amount less than full funding, would harm the 6.8 million women and children who participate in the program, putting their health and well-being at risk.

WIC provides pregnant, postpartum, and breastfeeding women, infants, and children up to age 5 in households with low-incomes with nutrition education, breastfeeding support, health care referrals, and access to vitally needed nutritious foods during the most essential times for healthy development.

Nutritious food is expensive, and the WIC benefits – including the CVB - allow families to purchase the nutritionally-tailored food they need to grow and thrive. Due to the better health outcomes associated with WIC, investment in the program also leads to reductions in spending on health care and special education.

By adopting the Senate-passed WIC funding levels, Congress will continue its 30-year bipartisan commitment to supporting WIC and ensure that any eligible family who applies can receive the program benefits. Any funding level less than the Senate-passed amounts is unacceptable and will harm the nutrition and health outcomes of mothers, babies, and young children across our nation.

Additionally, in any short-or-long term spending bill, Congress must include enforceable legislative language that will ensure funding agreed upon will be allocated and reach the very people it was intended to serve. Without explicit language, funding for WIC and other programs can be later rescinded, despite congressional authorization and appropriation.

We urge you to continue Congress' long-standing bipartisan support for WIC - as reflected in the Senate-passed bill - by fully funding the program and maintaining the current value

of the fruit and vegetable benefit. This support is needed in any short- or long-term spending bill.
